WELCOME & GREETING

CALL TO WORSHIP

For those times when we move in the shadows,
we come together, in the light, to find our joy in God.
For those times when we deceive ourselves,
**we come together in the truth,
to find forgiveness in fellowship.**
For those times when life has been revealed,
**we come together to touch grace
in the presence of the Spirit of Christ. Amen.**

CONFESSION

Although sin separates, God's love restores, so we
confess our sins before God and one another.

(Pause for silence and reflection.)

God of tangible love, **in darkness we walk in sin. Forgive our thoughts, words, and actions that harm you, others, and ourselves. Forgive us when we fail to live and speak your word. Bring us into your light, restore us to fellowship with one another, and embrace us with your love. Amen.**

WORDS OF ASSURANCE

Our holy God exists wholly in light. In God's presence all our sins are exposed and then cleansed by God's healing light. With the recognition and confession of our sins, today our sins are forgiven, in the name of Jesus Christ, our light and life. **Amen.**

PRAYER OF THE DAY

God of light, **in confessing our sins, we walk in light and abide in the fellowship of Jesus Christ. Give us courage to look boldly on our own failings, to speak the truth, and to receive your merciful forgiveness, for the sake of Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.**



FIRST READING: 1 JOHN 1:5-2:2

Lector: This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light and in him there is no darkness at all.

Pastor: If we say that we have fellowship with him while we are walking in darkness, we lie and do not do what is true;

Lector: but if we walk in the light as he himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.

Pastor: If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he who is faithful and just will forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Lector: If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us. My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin.

Pastor: But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous; and he is the atoning sacrifice for our sins,

Lector: and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.

Let nothing escape your light, but let all that we do be illuminated by your attention and your love. Lord, in your mercy, **hear our prayer.**

Gracious God, **our hearts overflow with thanksgiving at your mercy, and we long to show this gratitude in our lives. May generosity of spirit, of heart, and of wealth be our first step toward imitating you, whom we love, O Lord. Amen.**

CELEBRATING COMMUNITY: SACRAMENT OF HOLY COMMUNION

THE GREAT THANKSGIVING

The LORD be with you.

And also with you.

Lift up your hearts.

We lift them to the LORD.

Let us give thanks to the LORD our GOD.

It is right to give GOD thanks and praise.

O Divine Mystery we name as God, it is right and proper that we should come together as your people to offer you thanks and praise, acknowledging our utter dependence on you.

With holy creativity you wrote a new story, calling the world into being. In the story of the Hebrew people, we hear our own story, slowly discovering a world charged with your grace and glory, and growing in faith. You have taught us that wandering does not mean that we are lost. You have taught us that the journey is just as important as the destination.

Through the prophets, we draw closer to your way of life and love. In the surprising story of Jesus, we encounter you as God-with-us and are drawn to your light. With Jesus we are crucified and resurrected into new life, knowing that sin and death will never have the final word, for he is your Word, spoken to us and for us. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, we are bound in covenant one to another and to the common cause of seeing your will be done in our world.

WORDS OF INSTITUTION

We recall the stories of Jesus' birth and baptism, his ministry of healing and teaching, his proclaiming God's kingdom and re-shaping of the religious structures of his day.

We remember that the night before Jesus gave himself up for the sake of the world, he shared a meal with his disciples. He taught them and prayed for them, then took bread, gave thanks, broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying "Take and eat. This is my body, given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

Again, after supper, he took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it for all to drink, saying: "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, shed for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sin. Do this in remembrance of me."

PRAYER OF CONSECRATION

Let us pray. **Spirit of God, bless this loaf and this cup, transformed and transforming, so that as Christ becomes part of us, we might become part of him, bone of his bone, flesh of his flesh, symbols of God's work in this world. Amen.**

By eating this bread and drinking this wine we become one in hope...the hope that is ours in the Prayer that Jesus taught us:

**Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name;
thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against us;
and lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil.
For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever and ever. Amen.**

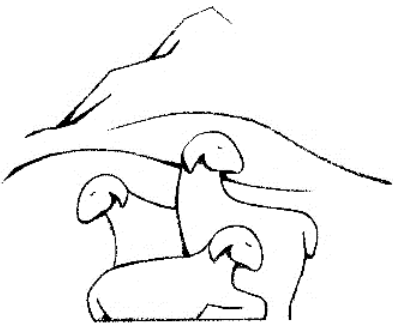

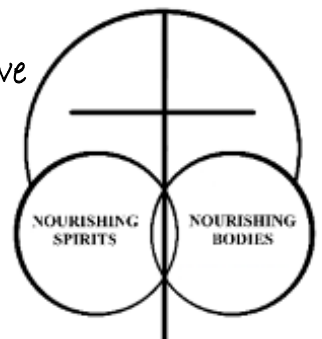
